#### Kirkby and Great Broughton report on activities at school.

Some more busy learning to report from KGB Primary School:

**In Reception and Nursery,** there has been lots of practice for the whole school sports day, the children can't wait to show us their skills on the track! Reception have had a wonderful trip to Monk Park Farm too.

**Year 1 children** have been learning about writing letters to characters and each other, lots of money skills in maths, and reading the book 'Dear Greenpeace'.





In Year 2 the children have been learning about Judaism and habitats

**In Years 3, 4 and 5**, the children have been learning all about the Stone Age . This term they had a special Stone Age Day where they learned how to use bows and arrows, made cave paintings with chalk and charcoal, made arrow heads from string, flint, feather and a stick. Then they got to hold real artefacts such as scrapers which were used to get the animal skins off. They also looked at the horns and bones of real animals!

**Y5** has also had an athletics tournament at the big school too in which they came second! Two Year 13 pupils from Stokesley School came to work with Y5 to do a lesson on Chromatography which involved a 'who done it'. We are hoping to have more lessons with the children from Stokesley School next year.

**Y6** have been busy filming school memories, painting new flags for sports day and creating contraptions to fly eggs whilst protecting them from breaking on impact – this has been particularly *eggciting*! In June they went away on an adventure to East Barnby for a whole week! We missed them but they were too busy to miss us doing activities such as body boarding, canoeing, dry-slope sledging, orienteering, and climbing! The teachers were super proud of the children who all faced new challenges with enthusiasm.

**Years 2, 5 and 6** had a visit from the NSPCC to learn about how to stay safe online and at home and the special Childline number 08001111 which can be called if we need help.

**Year 5 and 6** also had a visit from the Newcastle Building Society to learn about money and savings.

**Wild Cats' football** is starting up soon for two sessions KS1 and then KS2and we can't wait to practice our football skills with them!

We are looking forward to the long summer days and hope to report back again in September!

#### Great and Little Broughton Parish Council

There are several **public seating** benches around the parish currently in poor condition. The Parish Council is aware of these & has planned a programme of repair or replacement.

Following advice from the Tees River Trust, **grass** on the sides of Holme Beck will not be cut until at least late summer. This is to encourage wildflower development and provide additional wildlife habitat.

Parishioners are reminded that for reasons of hygiene, dogs are not currently permitted within the whole of the playpark, including the grassed areas.

G&L Broughton Parish Council is pleased to report agreeing construction of a dedicated **picnic and seating area** extension to village play park. Funded by the parish with a contribution from the North Yorkshire Council, it will provide a paved area with two bench-seated picnic tables situated on the currently grassed area to the left of the main gate.
