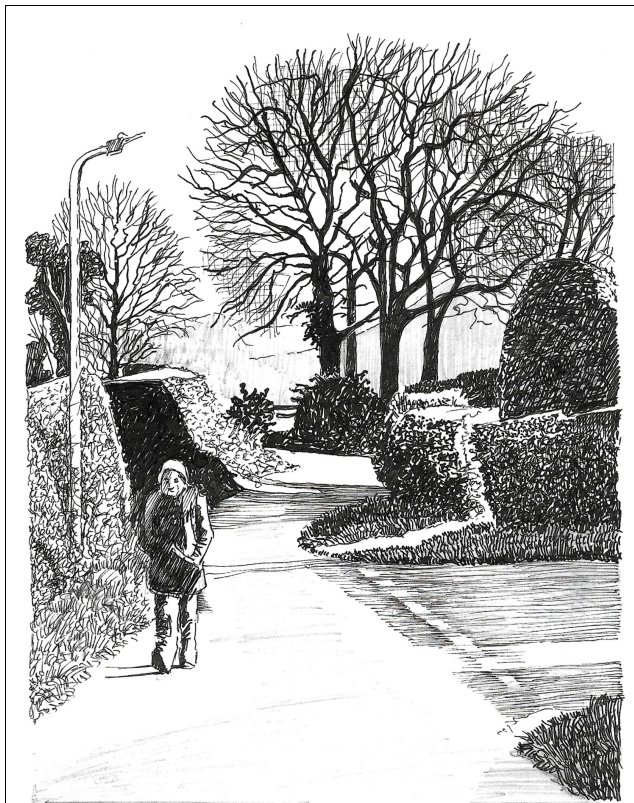

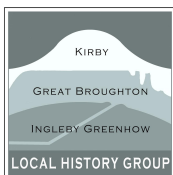

Photo ID now required when going to vote

At the General Election later this year, a **photo ID is now needed to vote**. If you don't have an accepted photo ID, get a free voter ID document, called a **Voter Authority Certificate**. If you have recently moved house, or become 18, please ensure that you are registered to vote at your current address and have the necessary photo ID, if you wish to vote in the General Election.
